

## Model Specific Maintenance

In addition to the Kia Basic Scheduled Maintenance, the following are Recommended Services for certain Kia models:

Every 12 months / 24,000 km

All Models, if equipped:  
> Replace cabin air filter

Every 16 months / 32,000 km

All Models:  
> Replace Manual transaxle fluid  
> Replace Automatic transaxle fluid (except Amanti /Magentis/ Soul/Forte Sorento (2011)— see other intervals listed below)  
Sorento:  
> Replace Transfer case fluid  
Sorento (2003-09) / Borrego:  
> Front & Rear differential service

Every 20 months / 40,000 km

2005 - Sportage/Sorento (2011):  
> Replace Transfer case fluid

Every 24 months / 48,000 km

All Models:  
> Replace engine air filter  
> Replace engine coolant  
> Replace fuel tank air filter  
Rio 1.5L / 1.6L, Soul 1.6L:  
> Replace spark plugs (Copper/Nickel)  
Amanti:  
> Replace Automatic transaxle fluid  
Forte/Koup / Soul / Sorento (2003-2006,2011):  
> Replace fuel filter

Every 28 months / 56,000 km

Rio (2006-)/Spectra (2005-)/Magentis (2007-)/Rondo / Amanti /Sportage (2005-)/Sedona (2006-)/Borrego:  
> Replace fuel filter  
Magentis (-2006) / Rondo:  
> Replace Automatic transaxle fluid  
Spectra (2005-) / 3.8L Sedona / Sorento (07-09) / Borrego:  
> Replace fuel filter

Every 32 months / 64,000 km

All Models:  
> Replace brake/clutch fluid  
> Replace all serpentine/accessory drive belts

Every 36 months / 72,000 km

Rio (-05) / Spectra (-04) / Magentis (-06) / Sedona (-05):  
> Replace fuel filter

Every 40 months / 80,000 km

Sportage (2005-), Sorento (2011-):  
> Rear differential service  
Forte / Koup / Spectra / Soul / Rondo / Magentis / Sportage (2005-10) 2.7L / Sportage (2011-) / Sedona (2006-) / Sorento (2007-) / Borrego:  
> Remove, inspect, clean & regap Iridium spark plugs

Every 48 months / 96,000 km

All Models (if equipped):  
> Replace timing belt  
Soul / Forte/Koup / Sorento (2011-):  
> Replace Manual transaxle fluid  
> Replace Automatic transaxle fluid  
Spectra/Magentis (2002-2006) /Amanti / Sportage 2.0L / Sorento 3.5L / Sedona 3.5L:  
> Replace spark plugs (Platinum)  
Spectra (2005-) / 1.6L Soul / Forte/Koup / Rondo / Sedona (2006-) / Sorento (2007-) / Borrego 3.8L:  
> Inspect valve clearance

Every 160,000 km

Forte/Koup / Spectra/ Soul / Rondo / Magentis / Sportage (2005-10) 2.7L / Sportage (2011-) / Sedona (2006-) / Sorento (2007-) / Borrego:  
> Replace spark plugs (Iridium)

# KIA BASIC SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE

## Service 1 > From \$

- > Replace engine oil and filter
- > Check fluid levels (power steering, brake/clutch, coolant, washer)
- > Check tire condition and pressure (including spare)
- > Check exterior & interior lights for proper operation
- > Check windshield washer/wiper function
- > Check horn function
- > Check handbrake function/freeplay
- > Lubricate all latches, hinges and locks

In addition to the Kia Motors Factory Recommended Service intervals listed above, your Kia may require additional time/mileage sensitive maintenance such as the replacement of vital fluids, filters, belts and spark plugs. Please consult your Kia Service Advisor and vehicle owner's manual for complete details.

## Service 2 > From \$

- > Replace engine oil and filter
- > Check fluid levels (power steering, brake/clutch, coolant, washer)
- > Check tire condition and pressure (including spare)
- > Check exterior & interior lights for proper operation
- > Check windshield washer/wiper function
- > Check horn function
- > Check handbrake function/freeplay
- > Lubricate all latches, hinges and locks
- > Inspect ignition wires
- > Check engine coolant specific gravity
- > Remove and inspect engine air filter
- > Remove tires and inspect brake system for proper operation, check pad/shoe thickness; inspect calipers/wheel cylinders for proper operation, leaks or damage; adjust rear breaks as necessary
- > Rotate tires
- > Visually check underbody fasteners for condition & integrity
- > Check clutch pedal freeplay; adjust as required\*
- > Check steering components for proper operation
- > Check CV boots/tie rods/ball joint boots (visual inspection)
- > Check all seat belts and anchor integrity
- > Check exhaust system for leaks, mountings, brackets, heat-shield\*
- > Check transfer case oil level & condition, fill as required\*
- > Check front & rear differential fluid, fill as required\*
- > Check manual transaxle oil level and condition, fill as required\*
- > Check auto transaxle fluid level & condition, fill as required\*
- > Road test vehicle

## Service 3 > From \$

- > Replace engine oil and filter
- > Check drive belt condition & tension
- > Check fluid levels (power steering, brake/clutch, coolant, washer)
- > Check tire condition and pressure (including spare)
- > Check exterior & interior lights for proper operation
- > Check windshield washer/wiper function
- > Check horn function
- > Check handbrake function/freeplay
- > Lubricate all latches, hinges and locks
- > Check engine coolant specific gravity
- > Remove and inspect engine air filter
- > Remove tires and inspect brake system, deglaze, clean, adjust & lubricate brake components as necessary
- > Rotate tires
- > Visually check underbody fasteners for condition & integrity
- > Check clutch pedal freeplay; adjust as required\*
- > Check steering components for proper operation
- > Check CV boots/tie rods/ball joint boots (visual inspection)
- > Check all seat belts and anchor integrity
- > Check exhaust system for leaks, mountings, brackets, heat shield\*
- > Check transfer case oil level & condition, fill as required\*
- > Check front & rear differential fluid, fill as required\*
- > Check manual transaxle oil level & condition, fill as required\*
- > Check auto transaxle oil level & condition, fill as required\*
- > Inspect fuel tank cap, lines, EVAP canister and hoses
- > Inspect PCV valve/system
- > Inspect power steering lines & hoses (visual)
- > Check A/C performance
- > Check brake line fittings, bleeder screws, booster for damage, looseness, leaks
- > Road test vehicle
